* Also excludes cancers originating from the following primary sites: reproductive (specifically ovarian, fallopian tube, or peritoneal; uterine or endometrial; and cervical), thyroid, digestive (specifically colon or rectal, small intestinal, or anal, biliary tract, and pancreatic), kidney or renal pelvis, and lung.

**These baseline and self-reported estimates are likely an over-estimate of the actual number of cases. Follow-up of incident cases has shown that melanoma tends to be initially reported in place of non-melanoma skin cancers or *in situ* melanoma.
